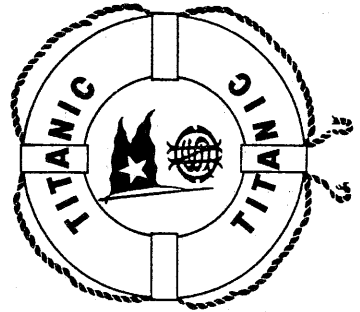

The crowning feature of the Titanic's interior was the GRAND STAIRCASE with a wrought iron and leaded glass dome, polished oak wall paneling and elaborate balustrades. There was an elaborate ornamental clock surrounded by two classical figures symbolizing HONOR and GLORY crowning TIME.
