



Board Member Roles and Responsibilities

SSHSA's continued and future success depends on the personal commitment and active involvement of a select group of elected individuals, who embrace the privilege to serve and the responsibility to lead. Board Members are expected to be zealous advocates on the SSHSA's behalf, enthusiastic communicators of its mission and vision, and to play an integral role in its leadership. As fiduciaries, Board Members embrace the principles of loyalty, duty of care and confidentiality in all their actions related to the organization.

TIME

- Attend all scheduled board meetings. Be prepared for those meetings and be willing to contribute
- Active participation on at least one Board Committee
- Be well informed about SSHSA's mission and strategies, policies, programs, strength, and needs and be willing to communicate those attributes to others
- Attend SSHSA hosted events and other related events as a representative of SSHSA

TALENT

- Lend your expertise (professional, hobby or otherwise) to the organization so that it may reach its optimum potential
- Connect people and/or resources to SSHSA that can help the organization to advance its mission (e.g. identify strong candidates for Board committee membership)

TREASURE

- SSHSA Board Members will consider SSHSA to be one of their top (three) charities and donate accordingly
- Have an active membership status; provide annual support and special campaign support at a level that reflects their giving ability and their status on the Board
- Participate in stewardship, cultivation, and other activities that add value to the philanthropic revenue stream
