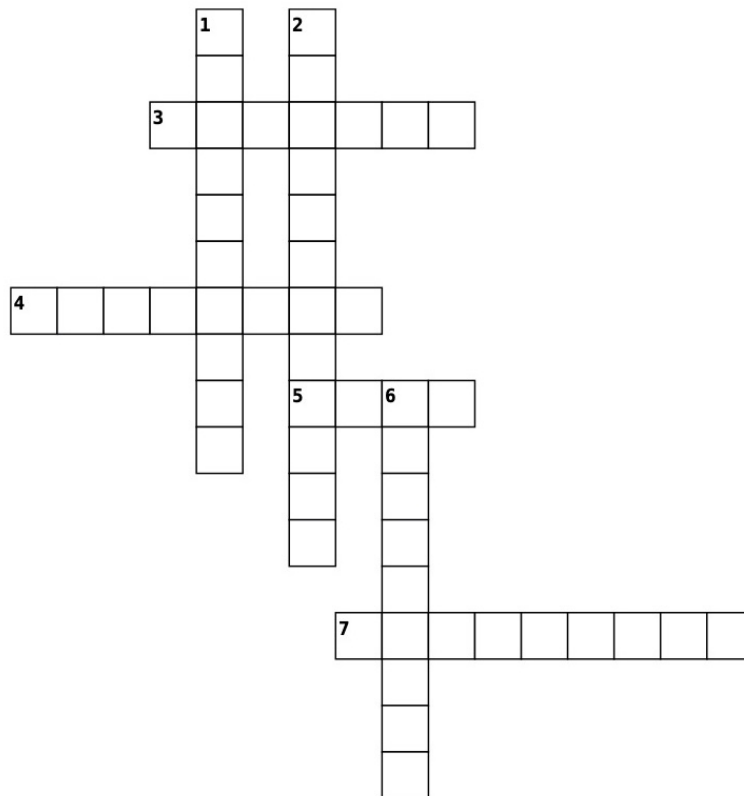




How Do Boats Float?
